

Following the Governor's office directive, the Hancock County Clerk's office will be closed to walk-in traffic starting Tuesday, March 17, 2020 at 4:00 PM. We will continue to process the mail, online and telephone transactions and prepare for the Primary Election on June 23, 2020.

Hancock County Clerk, Trina Ogle stated, "I am aware that this will inconvenience a lot of people, so I do not make this decision lightly. I also believe that we all need to make a large investment in social distancing to protect those most vulnerable to COVID-19. To do any less is simply not an option."

VEHICLE REGISTRATION AND TITLING

The public has several options to renew their vehicle registration.
